CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is Prince George Symphony Orchestra Society.
2. The objectives of the Society are as follows:
 - a) To maintain and operate a symphony orchestra.
 - b) To foster, promote, and encourage orchestral music and to produce orchestral or other musical performances for the purpose of furthering the objectives of the Society.
 - c) To purchase, lease, rent, build, sell, manage and otherwise acquire and dispose of buildings and property suitable for musical performances or rehearsals, storage of stage properties and the effects of the Society, meeting places, studios, and lecture halls as the Society may deem necessary in accordance with its objectives.
 - d) To purchase, lease, rent, build, sell, manage and otherwise acquire and dispose of stage properties, lighting and sound effect equipment, costumes, makeup and accessories, and all equipment of a mechanical or electrical nature which the Society may deem necessary in accordance with its objectives.
 - e) To become a member of or cooperate with any other society, association, or person for the purpose of furthering the objectives of the Society.
 - f) To support educational services relating to music for individuals, groups and institutions.
